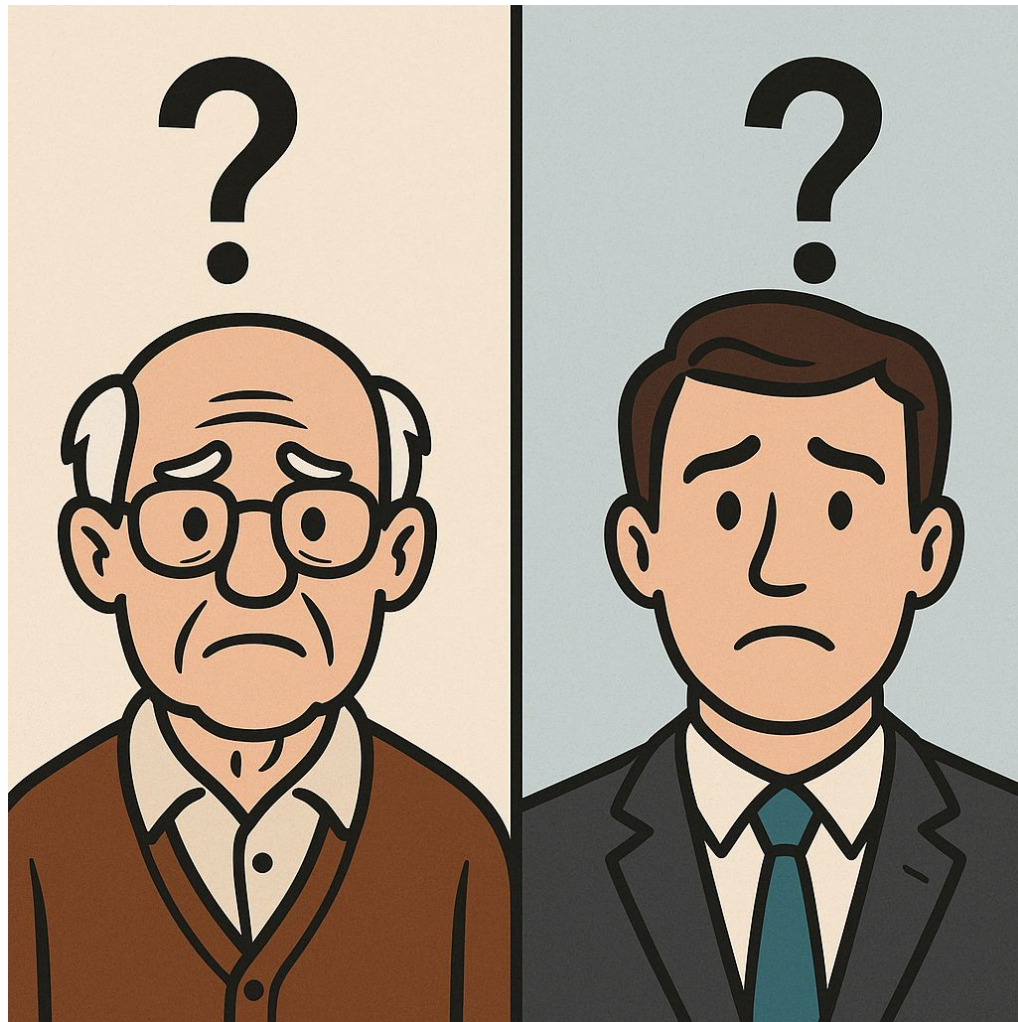

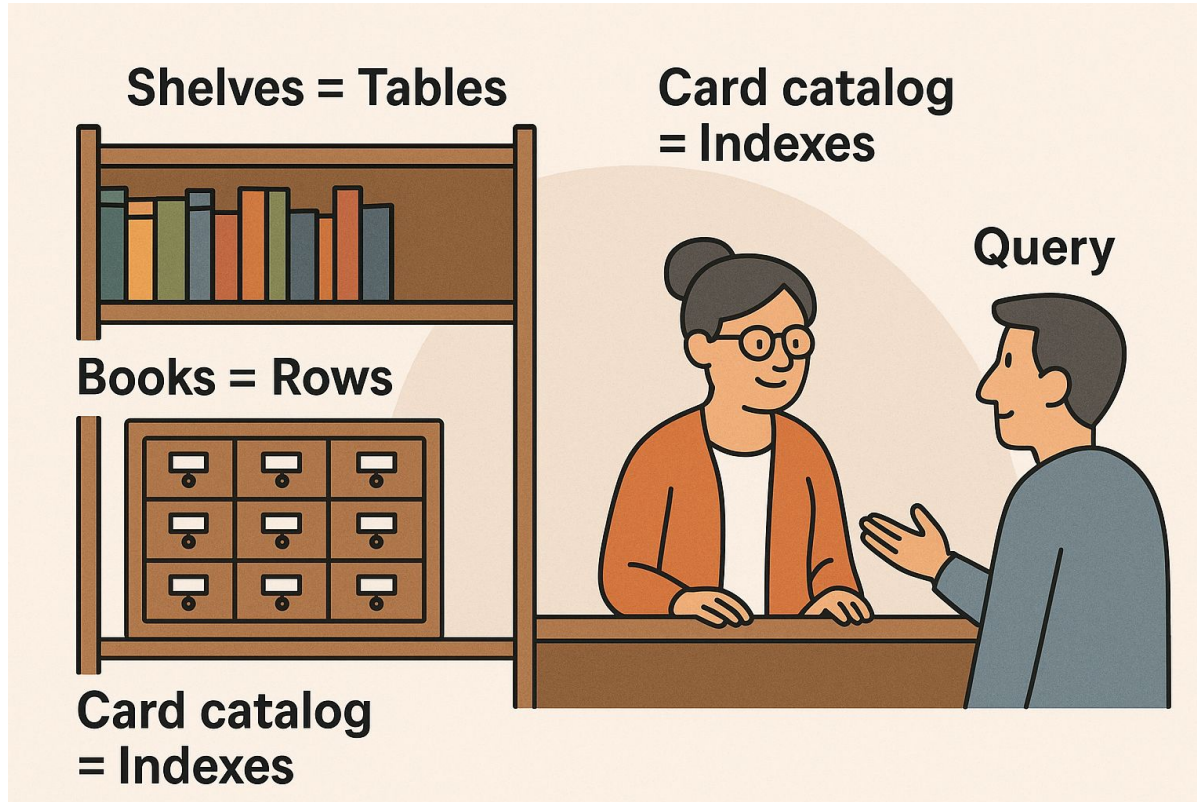


Why This Talk?

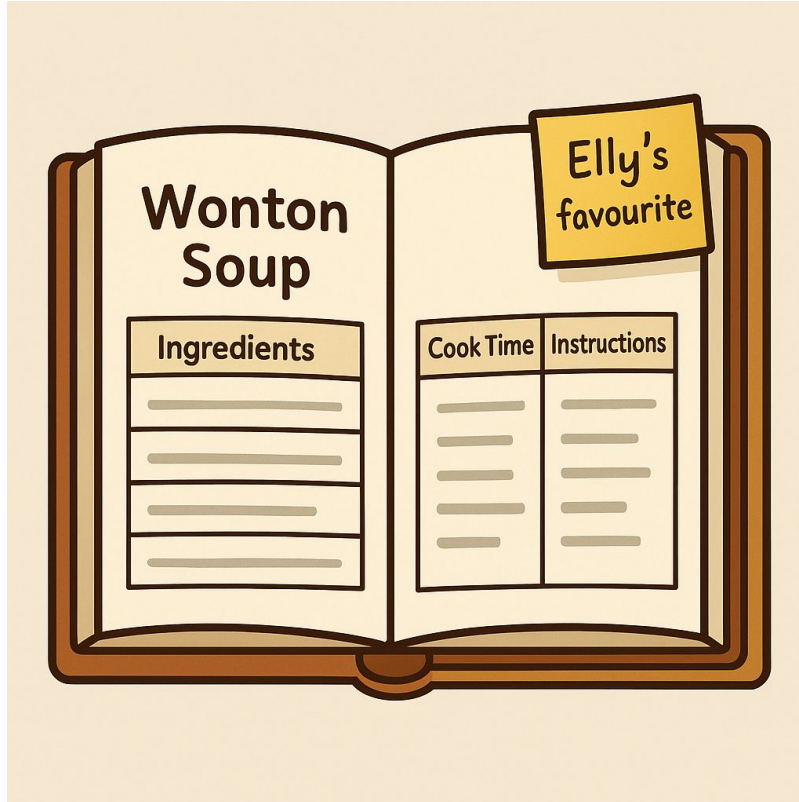
- We need better ways to talk about tech
